"A	(An))" i	S	used:

- 1. to introduce a **new noun** into a conversation An <u>accident</u> happened on the highway. (This is a new topic)
- 2. to show that you are talking about **one of many** things I saw a movie last weekend. (There are many movies to see, but I saw one)

"The" is used:

- 1. after a **new noun** has been introduced into a conversation The accident I saw was very terrible! (it was already a topic)

2. when the subject noun is when there is only one of something
