## **Quick -vs- Quickly (1 Answers)**

Adjectives are generally used to modify (change) nouns *He is a very tall man. / He is very tall.* Adverbs are used to modify verbs by adding "ly" We quietly walked into the room. \*\*If it ends in "y", change it to "ily" Bob is an incredibly smart guy.
