Regular: **big** Comparative: **bigger than** Superlative: **the biggest**
exciting **more exciting** **the most exciting**

Fill in the spaces with the correct adjective form as in the example below:

ex.) (fast transportation) - bus, train, plane

Buses are fast.

Trains are faster than buses.

Planes are the fastest transportation.

1. (**big** countries in the world) – The U.S., Canada, Russia

The U.S. is **big**.

Canada is **bigger than** the U.S.

Russia is **the biggest** country in the world.

2. (**old**) – Kim (94), Susie (96), Mary (99)

Kim **is old**.

Susie **is older than** Kim.

Mary **is the oldest**.

3. (**tall** mountain) – Mt. Fuji (3,776m), Mt. Kilimanjaro (5,875m),

Mt. Everest (8,848m)

Mt. Fuji **is tall**.

Mt. Kilimanjaro **is taller than** Mt. Fuji

Mt. Everest **is the tallest** mountain.

4. (**hot** month all year) – June, July, August

June is hot .

July is hotter than June .

August is the hottest month all year.

5. (**crowded** highways) – midday highways, evening highways,
morning highways

Midday highways are crowded .

Evening highways are more crowded than midday highways.

Morning highways are the most crowded .

6. (**cold** month all year) – December, January, February

December is cold .

January is colder than December .

February is the coldest month all year .

For the next ones, you have to decide which order to write the choices:

7. (**difficult** subject) – math, science, English

8. (**bright**) – star, moon, sun

9. (**beautiful** place) – Hawaii, Guam, Tahiti

10. (**bad** injury) – a broken finger, a broken leg, a broken nose

11. (**dangerous**) – sky diving, hang gliding, bungee jumping

12. (**good**) – Japanese food, Italian food, Chinese food
