## **Adjectives: Superlative (Answers)**

Superlative adjectives are used when you want to talk about something being the top, best, most, etc.

There are three kinds of superlative adjectives:

- 1. Ones that end in *-est*:  $big \underline{the} \ biggest$ ;  $happy \underline{the} \ happiest$
- 2. Ones that start with the most: expensive the most expensive
- 3. Special ones:  $good \underline{the} best$ ;  $bad \underline{the} worst$
- \*The best way to decide which to use is how long the adjective is.
  - \*\*short adjectives generally end in -est
  - \*\* long adjectives generally start with the most
