Can't - vs - Don't (2 Answers)

Can't is something that is <u>not</u> your choice or is impossible.

You can't swim across the ocean! (It is impossible)

Don't is something that is your choice, but you choose not to do.

Bob doesn't eat spicy food. (His choice. Maybe he hates it.)

1. We <u>can't</u> have pets here. The building manager said no pets allowed.
2. Wendy really hates fish, so she <u>doesn't</u> eat sushi.
3. The trains were stopped, so I <u>couldn't</u> get home. (*were is a past tense hint)
4. Kevin is allergic to shellfish and <u>can't</u> eat oysters. He also
<u>can't</u> even eat shrimp.
5. Barb and Kim <u>don't</u> like horror movies at all. They love comedies.
6. The hotel TV was broken, so we couldn't watch anything at night.
7. Terry is afraid of sharks, so she <u>doesn't</u> swim in the ocean.
8. Nathan <u>doesn't</u> ever clean his house because he is too lazy.
9. I forgot my keys at home and <u>couldn't</u> unlock the door to my office.
10. Hank <u>can't</u> swim. He never learned.
11. The test was so difficult that most of the students couldn't/didn't
pass it.
12. Larry broke his leg, so he <u>couldn't</u> play soccer for 2 months.
13. I don't have enough money to buy the new iPhone 25. It's so
expensive!
14. Pam spent all day watching the Olympics and <u>didn't</u> do the
laundry. Now she <u>can't</u> wear her favorite shirt tomorrow.
15. It was really cold and rainy, so we <u>couldn't</u> play outside today.
16. I was lazy and <u>didn't</u> go to the gym this weekend and I
couldn't go last weekend because I was very sick. I'll be so sad
if I <u>can't/don't</u> go next weekend!
17. Mom is mad because I played video games and <u>didn't</u> do my
homework.
18. Steve's wife is too busy and <u>can't</u> cook dinner every night. Steve
<u>doesn't</u> know how to cook, so they just order delivery food
every night.
19. I wanted to go to the music festival, but I couldn't get tickets. Too bad.
20. Ed forgot his wife's birthday and <u>didn't</u> buy her a birthday
present. Oops.
