For the first time in/since....(1)

This is used when you want to say that you haven't done something in some period of time.

For the first time <u>in</u>... refers to how long it has been
I played tennis today. The last time was 10 years ago.
I played tennis for the first time in 10 years.

For the first time <u>since</u>... refers to the last time/event you did it I played tennis today. The last time was in high school. I played tennis for the first time <u>since high school</u>.
