The pattern is: **have already + p.p. verb**

Would you like to order?

-Thanks, but **I've already ordered.**

*Answer the questions as in the example with have already p.p.verb:*

**ex.) Do you want to see the new Star Wars movie? (see)**

**I have already seen it.**
