*This is to say that you were **doing** some activity **when** something else happened*

The event happened in the past, but when it did, you were doing some action. So, you need: verb-ing...when...  
ex.) **I took a shower last night. You called me at that time.**  
**I was taking a shower when you called.**

**We were watching TV last night when the power went out** .

**Tim was scuba diving last year in Guam when he was attacked by a shark!**

**Sue was vacationing in Italy when she fell in love** .
10. I **ate** some raw oysters. Just then I started to feel very sick.  
**I was eating some raw oysters when I started to feel very sick** .
11. Alex **played** soccer on Sunday. At that time, he **injured** his leg.  
**Alex was playing soccer on Sunday when he injured his leg** .
12. I **shopped** for clothes. I soon realized I didn't have any money.  
**I was shopping for clothes when I realized I didn't have any money.**
13. We **ate** dinner at a restaurant. Just then our car was stolen.  
**We were eating dinner at a restaurant when our car was stolen.**
14. Ed **walked** through the park. At that time, he **found** a bag of money.  
**Ed was walking through the park when he found a bag of money.**
