

## I'm sorry, what's your NAME AGAIN? (1 Answers)

“Again” is used when you forgot what someone has told you or you couldn't hear what they said, and you politely ask again

*\*\*Remember: This must be the second or third time (or more times) to get this information!!*

ex.) You can't remember where someone is/I am from:

I'm sorry, where are you from again ?

1. You can't remember someone's **name**:

I'm sorry, what's your name again ?

2. You have forgotten where **John lives**:

I'm sorry, where does John live again ?

3. You weren't able to clearly hear Harry's phone number:

I'm sorry, what is Harry's phone number again ?

4. You couldn't hear what Susan does for her job: (**do**)

I'm sorry, what does Susan do ?

5. You have forgotten **how** to spell a person's name: (**how**; **your name**)

I'm sorry, how do you spell your name again ?

6. You couldn't hear **Bill's last name**:

I'm sorry, what is Bill's last name again ?

7. Someone calls you and you don't remember their **company's name**:

I'm sorry, what is your company's name again ?

8. You forgot **Emily's husband's name**:

I'm sorry, what is Emily's husband's name again ?

9. You can't remember Mary's email address:

I'm sorry, what is Mary's email address again ?

10. You forgot **how** many children I have:

I'm sorry, how many children do you have again ?

11. You can't remember what university Ed went to:

I'm sorry, what university did Ed go to again ?

12. You forgot the (musical) instrument that I play:

I'm sorry, what instrument do you play again ?

13. You completely forgot what my apartment number is:

I'm sorry, what is your apartment number again ?

14. You can't remember what Jane's hometown is:

I'm sorry, what is Jane's hometown again ?

15. You forgot what company I work for:

I'm sorry, what company do you work for again ?
