

## **Including tip, it was quite cheap!**

**Including something means you are giving a total amount for a group/thing that has that something in it or not**

9 people came to the party, **including me**. (8 people and me =9)

ex. 1) Party guests who came (9) ; with me (9)

**Nine people came to the party, including me.**

ex. 2) Party guests who came (9) ; \*with John (10)

**Nine people came to the party, not including John.**

Complete the sentences using the **bold numbers** as the base compared to the other numbers for including something or not, as in the examples:

1. TV ticket price (**\$1000**) ; \*amount I paid (\$1100) with tax

The TV price was **\$1000, not including tax**.

2. Days I've worked non-stop for (**15**) ; with today (15)

I've worked non-stop for **15 days including today**.

3. Number of members in our family is (**8**) ; w/ the dog & cat (8)

The number of members **in our family is 8, including the dog & cat.**

4. The cruise ship fee is (**\$2500**) ; with dinner (\$2500), \*with breakfast and lunch (\$2700) (2 parts) **The cruise ship fee is \$2500, including**

**dinner, but not including breakfast and lunch**.

5. The restaurant bill was (**\$200**) ; \*with tip (\$240)

**The restaurant bill was \$200, not including tip**.

6. The TV show is (**3hours, 15mins**) ; \*with commercials (4hours)

**The TV show is 3hours, 15mins, not including commercials**.

7. The own (**10 pairs of**) Levi's jeans ; with these jeans (10)

I own **10 pairs of Levi's jeans, including these jeans**.

8. My trip to NY (**7 days**) ; with travel time (7)

**My trip to NY was 7 days, including travel time**.

9. (**2**) bags on the airplane ; \*with carry-ons (3)

You can have **2 bags on the airplane, not including carry-ons**.

10. One school term is (**17 weeks**) ; \*with exams (18 weeks)

**One school term is 17 weeks, not including exams**.

11. Concert ticket price was (**\$130**) ; with parking (\$130)

**The concert ticket price was \$130, including parking**.

12. Move into my new apartment was (**\$4500**) ; \*with the movers (\$5300)

**The cost to move into my new apartment was \$4500, not including the movers.**
