

# Look -vs- Look like(b-1 Answers)

(this also works with the 4 other senses: *Sound, Smell, Feel and Taste*)

**Look** : When you can **see** something

**Sound** : When you **hear of** something

**Smell** : When you can **smell** something

**Feel** : When you are **touching** something

**Taste** : When you are **tasting** something

**look, sound, smell, feel** + adjective

This looks delicious!!

That news sounds terrible!

**look, sound, smell, feel, \*taste** + like + noun

This scarf feels like silk!

He looks like his grandfather!

Choose one of the senses from above with or without “like”:

1. Billy, you look tired. You should go to sleep.
2. What is that smell? It smells like someone is baking cookies.
3. I ate frog legs in France, and they taste(d) like chicken.
4. Jim's beard feels soft. You should touch it too.
5. I feel terrible. I feel like I'm catching a cold.
6. Lisa's new perfume smells like wine and roses!
7. Judy really looks like her mother. They look like sisters sometimes.
8. The new horror movie looks so scary!
9. Kim doesn't like going to the fish market because it smells fishy. She said it smells like rotten fish everywhere.
10. My new shoes feel really comfortable!
11. \*I saw the pictures of Tahiti in a magazine and it looks interesting.
12. \*I read about Tahiti in a book and it sounds interesting.
13. Amy's jacket feels like leather, but it's fake leather.
14. Your weekend plans sound great! Can I join you?
15. Eddie said the money was stolen, but it sounds like he's not telling the truth.
16. Paul's dirty room smells like old gym socks and it really looks like a tornado hit it. And his carpet feels sticky!
