## Look -vs- Look like(b-1 Answers)

(this also works with the 4 other senses: Sound, Smell, Feel and Taste)

Look : When you can see something Sound : When you hear of something Smell : When you can smell something Feel : When you are touching something Taste : When you are tasting something

look, sound, smell, feel+ adjectiveThis looks delicious!!That news sounds terrible!

**look, sound, smell, feel, \*taste** + <u>**like**</u> + <u>*noun*</u> This scarf feels like <u>*silk*</u>! He looks like <u>*his grandfather*</u>!

Choose one of the senses from above with or without "like":

- 1. Billy, you <u>look</u> tired. You should go to sleep.
- 2. What is that smell? It <u>smells like</u> someone is baking cookies.
- 3. I ate frog legs in France, and they <u>taste(d) like</u> chicken.
- 4. Jim's beard <u>feels</u> soft. You should touch it too.
- 5. I <u>feel</u> terrible. I <u>feel like</u> I'm catching a cold.
- 6. Lisa's new perfume <u>smells like</u> wine and roses!
- 7. Judy really <u>looks like</u> her mother. They <u>look like</u> sisters sometimes.
- 8. The new horror movie <u>looks</u> so scary!
- 9. Kim doesn't like going to the fish market because it <u>smells</u> fishy. She said it <u>smells like</u> rotten fish everywhere.
- 10. My new shoes <u>feel</u> really comfortable!
- 11. \*I saw the pictures of Tahiti in a magazine and it <u>looks</u> interesting.
- 12. \*I read about Tahiti in a book and it <u>sounds</u> interesting.
- 13. Amy's jacket <u>feels like</u> leather, but it's fake leather.
- 14. Your weekend plans <u>sound</u> great! Can I join you?
- 15. Eddie said the money was stolen, but it <u>sounds like</u> he's not telling the truth.
- 16. Paul's dirty room <u>smells like</u> old gym socks and it really <u>looks like</u> a tornado hit it. And his carpet <u>feels</u> sticky!
