No -vs- Not (1 Answers)

This sheet deals with using **no** *and* **not** *with the verbs* be *and* have:

No + (noun);(adj - noun) *No (thing/where/one/body)

She has no *friends* yet in her new town. (Sue knows no *one* here.) Bob has no *close family* in town.

Not + (adjective/verb(ing)) I'm not *interested* in it yet. John **is** not *joining* our club. Not + (a noun - singular) There was not *a house* standing after the tornado.

*Not (many/much/any) There is not *much* left to do.

*Not one's noun This is not Kim's wallet.

Choose **no** or **not** for the following sentences:

- 1. Tom's having a party, but I'm <u>not</u> going! It will probably be boring because there will be <u>**no**</u> one I know there.
- 2. I hope there is <u>no</u> snow this winter! Too much fell last year!
- 3. I had <u>no</u> money and <u>no</u> where to live when I came to Tokyo.
- 4. This is <u>not</u> my notebook. Mine has <u>no</u> stickers on it!
- 5. Tomoko is <u>not</u> happy about having to move to Ohio. It is **not** a cool place to live!
- 6. <u>No</u> one is answering the telephone. I hope it is <u>not</u> important.
- 7. We had absolutely <u>no</u> food left in our fridge after the 4^{th} of July party.
- 8. *There are **not** many people at the museum. There is **no** one at the ticket gate and <u>no</u> line in front. It is probably **not** a good exhibition.
- 9. Mary had **no** chance to visit me when she came to Tokyo because she had **no** free time.
- 10. Mary had <u>no</u> chance to visit me when she came to Tokyo because she was <u>not</u> free.
- 11. Sherry has <u>not</u> seen the new Star Wars movie yet. Actually, she has <u>no</u> interest in Sci-fi movies.
- 12. There was <u>not</u> much work to do in the office today and <u>no</u> managers, so we just spent the day doing <u>no</u> work at all.
- 13. They say there's <u>no</u> thing anyone can do to stop climate change, and that it's <u>not</u> our problem. I do <u>not</u> agree with this!!
- 14. People who say there's <u>not</u> a thing anyone can do to stop climate change. I think they are just <u>not</u> interested in changing the way they live their lives.
