

OTHER THAN soccer, what sports do you like?

This sheet deals with when you know a little about someone's story, but you want to get more information without them repeating what you already know.

You can do: **Other than verbing** or **Other than a noun**

John: I really love live sports! Last week I saw 4 soccer games!
Now you know that John likes soccer. You want to know what different sports he likes, so you say:

You: **Other than** soccer, what (other) sports do you like?

Ask for more information based on the sentences given using other than:

ex.) I bought eggs and milk at the store. (buy)

Other than buying eggs and milk, what did you buy at the store?

1. I **went** to Bali *last year*. (go last year - *where)

Other than going to Bali, where did you go last year ?

2. I **saw** a movie *this weekend*. (do)

Other than seeing a movie, what did you do this weekend ?

3. I **read** a comic book on Saturday. (read)

Other than reading a comic book, what did you read on Saturday?

4. I **studied** math last night. (study)

Other than studying math, what did you study ?

5. I **rode** the bicycle at the gym. (do there)

Other than riding the bicycle at the gym, what did you do there ?

6. I **met Mr. Ohtani** of the LA Angels at the game. (meet)

Other than meeting Mr. Ohtani of the LA Angels, who did you meet?

7. *Can we go shopping? I need some **new shoes**. (need to buy)

Other than (needing) new shoes, what do you need to buy ?

8. I went fishing and **caught** a huge trout. (catch)

Other than catching a huge trout, what did you catch ?

9. *Thieves broke into our house and **stole** my jewelry! (take)

Other than stealing your jewelry, what did they take ?

10. *Ed was in a terrible accident and **broke his leg**. (break)

Other than breaking his leg, what did Ed break ?

11. One of my hobbies is **scuba diving**. (are your hobbies)

Other than scuba diving, what are your hobbies ?

12. Hugh has 4 cars, and one is a **BMW**. (have)

Other than (having) a BMW, what cars does Hugh have ?
