Put on / Take off / Wear (b-1 Answers)

*Anything "on" your body: Clothes, jewelry, make-up, perfume, etc. <u>Put on/Take off</u> are just quick one-moment actions.

(put, put, put) / (take, took, taken)

I **put on** a pair of jeans this morning. (*Just a quick action*) When Kim got home she **took off** her school uniform.

<u>Wear</u> is not an action, but just the situation of something on one's body. Usually for a long period of time.

(wear, wore, worn)

He almost always wears socks when he sleeps.

*Pick **put on, take off,** or **wear** for the blanks below: (careful of tenses!)

- 1. Peter **<u>put on</u>** his coat and went out into the snow.
- 2. What perfume are you <u>wearing</u>? It smells great!

- 7. Bill took off his wedding ring at the gym and lost it somewhere.
- 8. I forgot to <u>**put on**</u> my belt this morning, so my pants are too loose!
- 9. The nurse told me to <u>take off</u> my clothes and <u>put on</u> a hospital robe.
- 10. I don't really like to <u>wear</u> flashy big jewelry.
- 11. Handcuffs were **<u>put on</u>** the man the police arrested.
- 12. Kids can't go to arcades if they <u>wear</u> their school uniform.
- 13. I **put on** my baseball helmet and went out to bat.
- 14. It's strange that some people <u>wear</u> socks when they sleep.
- 15. Mom told me to <u>take off</u> my nice clothes before I go out and play. She said I should <u>put on</u> old clothes in case they get dirty.

****<u>Put in / take out;</u>** These are for things that we actually

put "in" our bodies: Contacts, earrings (pierced), etc.

- 1. I fell asleep and forgot to <u>take out</u> my contact lenses.
- 2. The old man has to **put in** his hearing aid to hear you.
- 3. Betty, you should <u>take out</u> your earrings before exercising!
- 4. It took me a long time to get used to **<u>putting on</u>** my contact lenses.
- 5. Tom lost a tooth because he forgot to <u>**put in**</u> his sports mouthguard.
