

## So -vs- Because (1 Answers)

**So:** *A situation is happening, **SO** you do an action or get a result.*

The park doesn't have food, **so** I brought my lunch.

**Because:** *There is a reason or explanation **BECAUSE** of a situation.*

I brought my lunch **because** the event doesn't have food.
