Still, Already and Yet (1 Answers)

Still refers to something that is continuing now.

Did the rain stop, or is it <u>still</u> raining?
Already refers to something that is finished.
I don't want to see the new <i>Top Gun</i> movie. I've <u>already</u> seen it.
Yet refers to something that hasn't happened. (negative / question)
My big test is in 2 days and I haven't started studying <u>yet!</u>
Have you seen the new <i>Top Gun</i> movie <u>yet</u> ?
Have you seen the new <i>top oun</i> movie <u>yet</u> :
Choose still, already or yet to complete the sentences:
1. John is <u>still</u> taking the test. He hasn't finished <u>yet</u> , but the whole
class has <u>already</u> finished it.
