

## Still, Already and Yet (1 Answers)

*Still* refers to something that is continuing now.

Did the rain stop, or is it *still* raining?

*Already* refers to something that is finished.

I don't want to see the new *Top Gun* movie. I've *already* seen it.

*Yet* refers to something that hasn't happened. (negative / question)

My big test is in 2 days and I haven't started studying *yet*!

14. You're 15 minutes late! The movie has already started!
