Too, Too Much and Too Many (1 Answers)

Too is always followed by just an <u>adjective</u>.

Winters up north are **too cold** for me. I like warm weather.

Too much is generally followed by an uncountable noun.

Timmy spends too much time playing video games!

***You can also: verb too much I ate too much and feel sick!

Too many is generally followed by a <u>countable noun</u>.

Bob made too many mistakes at work and was fired.

- 1. Jimmy couldn't ride the roller coaster because he was **too** short.
- 2. Because there were <u>too many</u> people in the elevator, it was <u>too</u> heavy and wouldn't move.
- 3. I'd like a new car, but they're just <u>too</u> expensive these days.
- 4. Amy spent <u>too much</u> money on <u>too much</u> jewelry and is now broke.
- 5. It's too dark to see anything! Turn on a light!
- 6. The company dumped <u>too much</u> pollution for <u>too many</u> years into the river, and now all the fish have died. That's just <u>too</u> sad.
- 7. It was <u>too</u> troublesome to repair my motorcycle, so I sold it.
- 8. The exam was way <u>too</u> difficult for the students to do. <u>Too many</u> of the questions were <u>too</u> confusing for them to answer.
- 9. It snowed <u>too much</u> on Saturday and all trains were stopped for hours.
- 10. Eddie's <u>too</u> nice! <u>Too many</u> of his friends take advantage of him!
- 11. Rob's always complaining <u>too much</u> about his wife. He says <u>too many</u> horrible things about her.
- 12. The airline overbooked, so there were <u>too many</u> passengers. This kind of thing is happening <u>too many</u> times these days. It's so annoying.
- 13. The soup burned Matt's tongue because it was <u>too</u> hot.
- 14. *TMI* is an email expression for when someone has given us <u>too much</u> information about something personal and we don't want to hear anymore.
- 15. There was **too much** work to finish by 6:00, so I had to stay late.
- 16. <u>Too many</u> cars on the streets cause <u>too much</u> traffic. The highways are always <u>too</u> crowded and it takes forever to get anywhere.
- 17. Bob, you have <u>too much</u> stuff on your desk! There are <u>too many</u> sheets of paper spread out everywhere. Clean it up.
- 18. I have <u>too many</u> things to throw away before I move to my new apartment. I think I have <u>too much</u> furniture for the living room and <u>too many</u> pairs of shoes to fit in the closet, which is definitely <u>too</u> small.
- 19. Kimberly ate <u>too much</u> food at the buffet and feels sick. She really ate <u>too much</u> chocolate at the dessert table and that's probably why she feels so bad.
- 20. Rich people complain that they pay <u>too much</u> in taxes, but <u>too many</u> of them don't even pay as much as they should! There are just <u>too many</u> loopholes that let them only pay a small percent of what they should.
