Whole -vs- All (1 Answers)

Both whole and all mean 100% of something. But whole means a complete something (a whole bottle, a whole year, etc.) and all talks about a total amount of something (all the food, all my friends, etc.)

Whole: a, an, the, personal pronouns (my, your, our, etc.), or a number <u>always, always</u> come before whole, and is followed by a <u>singular noun</u> (or plural if using a number).

It took Joe a **whole** <u>week</u> to drive across America. We watched 3 **whole** seasons of that TV show in one day.

All: a, an, the, personal pronouns (my, your, our, etc.), or a number <u>never, never</u> come before all (they usually come after all) Dan went on all (of) <u>the</u> rides at the amusement park. Bill has 5 sisters, and all <u>5 of them</u> are doctors.

- 1. Steve & Mark ate <u>all</u> the pizza. (*a total amount of pizza*)
- 2. Steve & Mark ate the <u>whole</u> large sized pizza. (*a complete pizza*)
- 3. Hector has lived <u>all</u> his life in Spain, so he knows <u>all</u> the best sightseeing spots.
- 4. Hector has lived in Spain his <u>whole</u> life and knows <u>all</u> the best sightseeing spots.
- 5. Our team lost <u>all</u> of our games last season.
- 6. My brother drank <u>all</u> of my tea when I went to the restroom.
- 7. Susie ate a <u>whole</u> box of chocolates and felt sick all day.
- 8. I found a <u>whole</u> bag of money, but I lost <u>all</u> of it gambling.
- 9. I bought a pie for dessert, but Susie and Melanie ate the <u>whole</u> thing after lunch.
- 10. Diane drank a <u>whole</u> bottle of wine during lunch and slept <u>all</u> day.
- 11. Sherry spent a <u>whole</u> month in Brazil, living in the rain forest.
- 12. Diane is happy that **all** her kids went to Harvard.
- 13. My neighbor made a lot of noise <u>all</u> night long.
- 14. John traveled for 3 <u>whole</u> months around Europe, spending the <u>whole</u> time traveling by bicycle.
- 15. <u>All</u> the drinking water sold out in Tokyo quickly after the big earthquake.
- 16. Nearly the <u>whole</u> country was covered in snow after the snowstorm.
- 17. Barbara spent <u>all</u> month in the hospital after her surgery.
- 18. That eating champion can eat 5 <u>whole</u> hamburgers in 2 minutes.
- 19. Almost <u>all</u> of Timmy's friends came to his birthday party.
- 20. I dropped a <u>whole</u> bottle of Tabasco in my kitchen and my house smelled like hot sauce <u>all</u> week. (True Story!)
