## **Passives and Actives(1)**

Active English is when the person/thing doing the verb (action) is said before the verb *Amy* **cooks** food for everyone. (Amy = person; **cooks** = verb) *The teacher* **taught** us math. (*The teacher* = person ; **taught** = verb) **Passive English** is when the person/thing doing the verb (action) is not said before the verb (sometimes after with "by") \*\* This form uses: be + p.p. verbFood is **cooked** for everyone (by Amy).
