invited to come over *made leave* *called the army*
12. The leaders couldn't agree and **walked away from** peace talks.
traveled to *came together* *left/abandoned*
13. After fighting her disease for years, Grandma finally **slipped away**.
got better *escaped* *died*
14. Eric, can you help me **put away** the groceries before you go play?
place in the usual place *eat* *go shopping together*
15. Bob put his car in 5th gear and **pulled away** from the other racers.
moved far ahead of *moved behind* *blew his engine*
