5. The family **sold** off their land little by little over the years.

pay **shut** **drop** **go** **call**

2. The bomb was set to explode at 12pm, but it didn't **go** off.
3. I've finally finished **paying** off my credit card debt! Yay!!
4. The festival was **called** off due to the coming typhoon.
5. The post office **dropped** off a package for you while you were out.
