Use **all, every, no, none, always, never** or leave it **blank** in these spaces:

1. That boy almost always falls asleep in class and almost never does his homework. It makes his teachers so mad!!
2. Billy almost XXXX got a goal in his first soccer game.
3. Almost every thing I own was stolen in the home robbery.
4. I've read almost all of Stephen King's books. They're great!
5. Almost none of the bands were good at the show. It was so boring!
6. Tim is a health nut. He almost never eats fried food. Almost all the food he eats has almost no calories.
7. I almost XXXX started a fire when I fell asleep while cooking!
8. Almost all the countries in the world dislike America these days because the President has said bad things about almost every country! Almost every thing he says is so negative!
9. Keiko slipped on the wet floor and almost XXXX fell down.
10. Almost no young people ski these days. It's just not so popular. Almost all of them prefer snowboarding to skiing.

Helpful reminders:

1. **All, every, no** and **none** are followed by a noun!
***All** is followed by a plural noun / **Every** by a singular noun!
2. **Always** and **never** are followed by a verb!
3. *If the verb is in the past tense, then leave it blank.
