

Another -vs- Other (1)

Another refers to a *different* thing or group of items, people, etc.

(**ex.1**) or it means one more/one different of something(**ex.2**)

ex 1: *I have many friends. One friend is a doctor, **another** is a lawyer and **another** is a police officer.*

ex 2: *I finished my beer. Can I have **another** one?*

****Single countable nouns follow **another**!!**

Other refers to **different** members of *one same* original group.

ex: *Some people like big dogs and **other people** like small dogs.*

*(People is the original group: Some people-**Other people**)*

****Other is followed by a plural noun (pens) or uncountable nouns.**
