be SUPPOSED TO - Should/Have to/ Must do (1)

This **supposed to** deals with things you should do/have to do/must do/etc.

***be supposed to + VERB → (should/must/have to do that VERB) Amy is supposed to **be** at her desk at 8:00! (She has to/must **be** at her desk at 8:00!) ***be not supposed to + VERB → (should not/must not/not have to VERB) You are not supposed to write in your school books! (You should not write in them) Rewrite the sentences with **be** (right tense) **supposed to** + **verb** as in the examples: ex.1) You must wear a tie in the office every day! You are supposed to wear a tie in the office every day! ex.2) Timmy should not play video games until he does his homework. Timmy is not supposed to play video games until he does his homework. 1.
