- 11. \*Sam <u>neither</u> wishes to <u>see nor talk</u> to me ever again, after I cheated on her. (see/talk 0 items)
- 12. I can speak **both French and German**. (French/German 2 items)
- 13. \*\* either you tell Ms. Smith that you lied, or I will ! (you tell/I will 1 item)
- 14. Neither you nor Jack are good enough to marry my young daughter!! (you/Jack 0 items)
- 15. The flowers are from <u>either Bob or Steve</u>. I can't remember who sent them! (Bob/Steve 1 item)
