

## Both..and/Neither..nor/Either..or!

You can pair the following combinations together:

1. **Both A and B : (2 items)** I like **both pizza and pasta.**
2. **Either A or B : (1 item)** I can go **either Sat. or Sun.**
3. **Neither A nor B : (0 items)** I **neither play nor watch** sports.
