Few -vs- Little (Answers)

<u>Few</u> is always used with <u>countable nouns</u>

There were **few** <u>people</u> at the shop's grand opening party. <u>Little</u> is always used with <u>uncountable nouns</u>

I had **little** *money* left after my vacation to Tahiti.

*<u>Little</u> is also used with *the size* of things, and not *how many* Many girls like little dogs. (*This is about their <u>small</u> size*)

2. The President answered <u>few</u> questions after his speech.

3. We were late getting to the airport, so we had <u>little</u> time to relax before our flight. I was only able to buy a <u>few</u> souvenirs.

6. My iPhone battery has very <u>little</u> power left.

7. There are <u>few</u> girls who really like bloody horror movies.
