I'm Having my house Painted!!(1)

This sheet is for when you "have something done".

To have something done means to have someone else do the work.

"I'm having my house painted!" says that I am **NOT** doing the painting, but someone else is doing it for me.

"I'm painting my house!" generally means that **I AM DOING** the painting myself.
