Have something done (2)

I'm *Having* my house *Painted!!(2)*

This sheet is for when you "have something done".

<u>To have something done</u> means to have someone else do the work. "*I'm having my house painted!*" says that I am **NOT** doing the painting, but someone else is doing it for me.

"I'm painting my house!" generally means that **I AM DOING** the painting myself.
