- 1. **not hit** something: *Bill swung his bat, but missed the ball.*
- 2. **fail to** hear/get/notice/see/be somewhere/go somewhere:

I missed the highway exit and had to drive 3Km before I could turn around. Amy had the flu and missed my party.

- 3. **not understand** something: You missed the point as to why I quit!
- 4. **be (too) late for**: *If we don't leave right now, we'll miss <u>our flight!</u>*
- 5. something is **not where it should be**: *My keys* are missing! I can't find them anywhere.
- 6. **sad** because you can no longer see someone/do something, or go somewhere: Dad died years ago, but I still miss <u>him</u> so much.
