

## **I didn't eat ANYTHING today! (2 Answers)**

*This expression is used to say that not any(thing, one, where, etc.) happened, was met, etc. when talking about some situation*

ex.) **I was really busy and had no food today! (eat)**

**I didn't eat anything today!**

*Change the following sentences to say not anything/anyone/anywhere/ etc. as in the example:*

1. I stayed home all weekend. (go)

**I didn't go anywhere all weekend** .

2. There were no people I knew at the party. (know)

**I didn't know anyone at the party** .

3. \*I looked for the lost treasure, but found none of it. (find)

**I looked for the lost treasure, but I didn't find anything** .

4. I went shopping, but only window shopped. (buy)

**I went shopping, but I didn't buy anything** .

5. Sherry was too tired to cook last night.

**Sherry was tired and didn't cook anything last night** .

6. Bill played bingo on Saturday, but didn't win any prizes.

**Bill played bingo on Saturday, but didn't win anything** .

7. I turned on the TV, but there were no good programs. (watch)

**I turned on the TV, but didn't watch anything** .

8. I talked to no people all weekend!

**I didn't talk to anyone all weekend** .

9. We went fishing but caught no fish!

**We went fishing, but didn't catch anything** .

10. The homeless man had no place to stay. (have)

**The homeless man didn't have anywhere to stay** .

11. I went to a game center, but I played none of the games.

**I went to the game center, but didn't play anything** .

12. A typhoon hit, so we went nowhere during our vacation.

**A typhoon hit, so we didn't go anywhere during our vacation.**

13. Tina lived alone for 90 years and married no one. (marry)

**Tina lived alone for 90 years and didn't marry anyone** .

14. \*When arrested, the thief said he stole nothing and hurt no one.

**When arrested, the thief said he didn't steal anything and didn't hurt anyone** .
