## Not Anything (2)

## I didn't eat ANYTHING today! (2)

This expression is used to say that **not any(thing, one, where, etc.)** happened, was met, etc. when talking about some situation

## ex.) I was really busy and had no food today! (eat) <u>I didn't eat anything today!</u>
