## <u>Say - Tell – Speak (1 Answers)</u>

You generally can:

say (said, said) something to someone (Please say hello to your mom.)
tell (told, told) someone something (Please tell your mom hello.)

speak (spoke, spoken) to someone (I have to speak to my teacher about the test.)
\*\*speak and talk are both used the same way: talk to someone

Special cases:

\* What did <u>someone</u> say <u>to/about someone</u>? / What did <u>someone</u> tell <u>someone</u>? \* tell a lie, a secret, a story, a joke etc.

- 1. Could you <u>speak</u> to the neighbors about their noisy dog? I keep <u>telling</u> them to keep it quiet, but it never stops barking!
- 2. Tina's stylist <u>told</u> her she looked good with blue hair, but I <u>said</u> it looks terrible.
- 3. Tina's stylist <u>said</u> she looked good with blue hair, but I <u>told</u> her it looks terrible.
- 4. The President came and <u>spoke</u> to the students at our school. He <u>said</u> all kids should help protect the environment, and <u>told</u> us to keep working hard.
- 5. Bill always <u>says</u> he'll be on time, but he never is. I often <u>tell</u> him that he's going to get fired if he keeps being late.
- 6. Kelly told me to tell you that she'll be arriving on the 10:30 flight.
- 7. What did you <u>say</u> to the teacher that made her cry?
- 8. Could you <u>tell</u> your mom I <u>say/said</u> hello (to her)?
- 9. Could you <u>tell</u> everyone at the party that I <u>said</u> I'm sorry I couldn't go?
- 10. Tom <u>said</u> that I cheated on the test, but when I <u>spoke</u> to our teacher, she <u>told</u> me she knew that I didn't do it.
- 11. The earthquake hit while I was <u>speaking</u> to Kim on the phone.
- 12. I really need to <u>speak</u> to Robert about this continuing problem in the office.
- 13. What did I <u>tell</u> you about running with scissors? Don't do it!! I've <u>said</u> it a thousand times!
- 14. Matt finally <u>said</u> that he had stolen the money when our boss <u>told</u> the staff that she would call the police if no one <u>told</u> the truth.
- 15. I was <u>speaking</u> to Nancy and she <u>told</u> me a really big secret. I promised I wouldn't <u>tell</u> anyone her secret.
- 16. What did Nick <u>say</u> to the police? Because after he <u>spoke</u> to them, they quickly left.
- 17. What did Nick <u>tell</u> the police? 'Cuz after <u>speaking</u> to them, they quickly left.
- 18. It is said that President Abraham Lincoln never <u>told</u> a lie.
- 19. My angry mom <u>spoke</u> to us for an hour and <u>told</u> us to keep our room clean.
- 20. Ann <u>told</u> me that she was home last night, but when I <u>spoke</u> to Bob, he <u>said</u> that she went dancing. I think she didn't want him to <u>tell</u> me that.
