

I SHOULDN'T HAVE eaten that!! (1)

*When you say you **shouldn't have** done something, you think that it was a bad idea to have done that and you regret it.*

Using this is: **should have + p.p.verb**

I shouldn't have eaten the oysters (because they smelled bad).
