Similar (to) talks about how things are alike or nearly the same
Christmas dinner is <u>similar to</u> Thanksgiving dinner in America.
*Christmas and Thanksgiving dinners in America are similar.

Different (from) talks about how things are <u>not</u> alike Monet paintings are very <u>different form</u> Picasso paintings.
*Monet and Picasso paintings are very <u>different</u>.
*Note: When near the end of a sentence, don't add to or from!
