This sheet deals with getting someone to **do** or **not do** something

talk someone into (verbing): get them to do something that they *didn't want to do* at first

I said, "No." at first, but Joe **talked me into moving** to Japan. <u>Talk someone out of (verbing)</u>: get them to not do something that they *wanted to do* at first

I was going to steal a guitar, but Kim **talked me out of stealing** it. *Rewrite the sentences, changing them into*: **talked someone into/out of**:

1. I wanted to get my nose pierced, but Sue said it was a bad idea. So, I didn't.

I wanted to get my nose pierced, but Sue talked me out of it

- 5. I didn't want to, but Beth got me to move in with her. Beth talked me into moving in with her
- 6. Pam said it looked too terrible, so I didn't buy the pink sweater. Pam talked me out of buying the terrible pink sweater
- 7. I didn't marry Ann 'cuz Max said she only wants my money.
 Max talked me out of marrying Ann because she only wants my money.
- 8. Jenn had really long hair, but her stylist got her to cut it short.

Jenn had really long hair, but her stylist talked her into cutting it short.

9. *Tim wanted to get a tattoo on his neck, but his wife got him to get one on his back. (*make 2 sentences*)

<u>Tim wanted to get a tattoo on his neck, but his wife talked him out of it. She talked him into getting one on his back</u>.

- 10. I wanted to play football, but my mom got me to play tennis. <u>I wanted to play football, but my mom talked me into playing tennis.</u>
- 11. I didn't want to do it, but Max got me to invest in his company. Max talked me into investing in his company

12. Billy wanted to watch a horror movie, but I told him he wouldn't be able to sleep after watching it, so he didn't.
Billy wanted to watch a horror movie, but I talked him out of it.
