To Verb -vs- Verbing (2 Answers)

You can:

*try, start, begin, prefer, continue to verb or verbing
(I went home, but Tom continued to drink/drinking.)
*plan on, avoid, stop, quit, finish, suggest verbing
(To really learn Japanese, I suggest moving to the countryside.)
*plan, decide, forget, promise, refuse, learn to verb
(Mom refused to speak to me when I decided to get a tattoo.)

9. At the wedding, I promised <u>to love</u> my wife the rest of my
life, but now we avoid <u>talking</u> to each other. (love/talk)
10. I tried to break/breaking up with Kim, but she began to cry/crying
and refused <u>to listen</u> to me. (break/cry/listen)
11. Luckily, I decided <u>to grab</u> my umbrella just before it began
to pour/pouring rain. (grab/pour)
12. I prefer to take/taking the train to driving a car to work. (take)
13. I stopped <u>eating</u> meat and decided <u>to live</u> on a diet of
only vegetables. (eat/live)
14. Mom feels great since she quit <u>smoking</u> last year and refuses
to start to smoke/smoking ever again (smoke/start/smoke)
