Tried to do -vs- Did (1 Answers)

When you say you tried to do something, it generally means that you didn't or couldn't do it. (You were unsuccessful)
I tried to connect to the internet, but my wi-fi was down.

When you say you **did** something, it means that you were successful. I <u>connected</u> to the internet when they fixed my wi-fi.

- 1. I <u>tried to buy</u> concert tickets for the festival, but they were sold out. (buy)
- 2. Bob <u>got</u> a haircut for just \$5 and it looks pretty good! (get)
- 3. Mike was late for work, but he said he really <u>tried to arrive</u> on time. He said it was because there was an accident on the highway. (arrive)
- 4. I <u>saw</u> Bohemian Rhapsody and it is a great movie! (see)
- 5. Peter took the entrance test last year and said it was so hard. (take)
- 6. We <u>tried to eat</u> at that new restaurant, but the line was too long, so we just <u>ordered</u> a pizza and went home. (eat / order)
- 7. After the big earthquake, I <u>tried to call</u> my family, but the phones weren't working, so I <u>sent</u> them an email to tell them I was OK. (call / send)
 8. The thief <u>tried to run</u> from the police, but fell down and they easily
- 8. The thief <u>tried to run</u> from the police, but fell down and they easily <u>caught</u> him and <u>put</u> him in the back of their police car. (run / catch / put)
- 9. Years ago Judy <u>tried to marry</u> a rich guy, so she often <u>went</u> to a bar where rich businessmen <u>drank</u> and <u>tried to get</u> one of them to ask her out on a date. Unfortunately, none ever asked her out. (marry / go / drink / get)
- 10. Ron <u>broke</u> his computer when he <u>tried to set</u> it up himself. A computer tech <u>tried to fix</u> it, but he said it was impossible. Ron should have just <u>bought</u> a tablet. (break / set / fix / buy)
- 11. I <u>looked</u> everywhere for my keys, but couldn't find them and so I couldn't drive to work. First, I <u>tried to grab</u> a taxi, but one never came. Then I <u>tried to take</u> a bus, but the bus drivers are refusing to work. Finally, I <u>put</u> out my thumb and <u>hitchhiked</u> to work. (look / grab / take / put / hitchhike)
- 12. Dan's <u>tried to make</u> a fire at the campsite, but he forgot to bring matches. So, he <u>ate</u> cold canned food for dinner. (make / eat)
- 13. Sue <u>tried to ride</u> the roller coaster at the amusement park, but was too short. She then <u>put on</u> big soled shoes and <u>tried to trick</u> the staff, but it didn't work. They still said no. (ride / put on / trick)
- 14. Tom <u>woke</u> up at 5 am this morning and <u>went</u> fishing.
 He <u>tried to catch</u> some fish for dinner, but unfortunately, he didn't get one fish! (wake / go / catch)
- 15. Alex amazingly <u>taught</u> himself how to play guitar, but couldn't find anyone to play with when he <u>tried to start</u> a band. (teach / start)
