Big, Bigger, the Biggest! - Story

*Theses sheets deal with **Comparative** and **Superlative** adjectives*

Adjectives: *These just describe nouns* Russia is **big**.

Comparatives: *These are used when you are comparing 2 or more things* Russia is **bigger than** America.

Superlatives: *These are used to say something is the number 1 or top of some category* Russia is **the biggest** country in the world.

(famous)

It's more famous than the church her best/good friend got married in.
(famous) *(good)*

(young) *(beautiful)*

flowers and gorgeous decorations. She hopes the weather will
(gorgeous)

be sunny/sunnier and warmer than today. Today was the coldest
(sunny) *(warm)* *(cold)*

day all month. Getting married will be the happiest, but also the
(happy)

scariest thing she has ever done. She really loves her kind
(scary) *(kind)*

fiancée. He's more interesting than her ex-boyfriends and is very
(interesting)

handsome. The hardest part of the wedding is her long white
(handsome) *(hard)* *(long)* *(white)*

wedding gown. It's the most glamorous and the most expensive
(glamorous) *(expensive)*

dress she's ever had, but it's very heavy and tight. It's even
(heavy) *(tight)*

tighter than her nurse's uniform! She really hopes her crazy
(tight) *(crazy)*

drunk uncle doesn't come. He's the most embarrassing person
(drunk) *(embarrassing)*

in her family! She's so excited and nervous about tomorrow,
(excited) *(nervous)*

that she can't sleep. Tomorrow will be the most wonderful day ever!!
(wonderful)
