This sheet deals with **Comparative** and **Superlative** adjectives as you've done before,
but now **Adjectives** vs **Adverbs** have been added

Adjectives are generally used to modify (change) nouns

He is a very tall man. / He is very tall.

Adverbs are used to modify verbs or other adjectives by adding “ly”

We quietly walked into the room. / It was an extremely spicy pizza.

****If it ends in “y”, change it to “ily”*

(loud) *(loud)*

at a huge sports arena. Her father was smiling happily and her
(huge) (happy)

mother was crying noisily . As she and her handsomely -dressed
(noisy) (handsome)

husband took their slow walk back down the aisle, her excited
(slow) (excited)

friends threw beautifully decorated flowers on the long red
(beautiful) *(long)* *(red)*

carpet in front of them. Suddenly, her crazy drunk Uncle Bob
(sudden) *(crazy)* *(drunk)*

started jumping and shouting crazily ! To Susie's huge shock and
(crazy) (huge)

surprise, he had secretly drunk the whole giant bottle of whiskey!!
(secret) *(giant)*
