

Quick -vs- Quickly (1 Answers)

*This sheet works with **adjectives and adverbs!***

Adjectives are generally used to modify (change) **nouns**

She is a very beautiful woman. / She is very beautiful.

Adverbs are used to modify **verbs** or other **adjectives** by adding "ly"

We quietly **snuck** into the movie theater.

*When modifying adjectives, the adverb tells you "how **adjective**" the situation is:*

Tom is incredibly **rich**. (How **rich** is Tom? -**Incredibly rich!**)

****If the adjective ends in "y", change it to "ily"**

The children happily **played** in the park.

****If the adjective ends in "e", delete it and change it to "ly"**

Bob is an amazingly **smart** guy.

5. Jim Carey is a very funny actor. I laugh uncontrollably every time I see his movies. (**funny/uncontrollable**)
6. The teacher shouted loudly over the loud students. (**loud/loud**)
7. The artist played the piano and sang really beautifully. (**beautiful**)
8. That restaurant is delicious and cheap. (**delicious/cheap**)
9. The helicopter pilot flew dangerously close to the tall buildings. (**dangerous**)
10. Everyone was silent when the bride walked into the church. (**silent**)
11. Since their wonderful wedding day, Eric and Melanie have been very happily married for 55 years. (**wonderful/happy**)
12. Some of these new video games are way too violent for kids. (**violent**)
13. You should act more carefully while driving. (**careful**)
14. The students silently took their tests, because the teacher wanted complete silence during the test. (**silent/complete**)
15. The starving man hungrily ate his food. (**hungry**)
16. A Ferrari is an extremely fast car. (**extreme/fast**)
17. The mother gently brushed her baby's soft hair. (**gentle/soft**)
18. Everyone cheerfully sang the Christmas songs. (**cheerful**)
19. Only five students correctly answered the question. (**correct**)
20. Only five students gave the correct answer to the question. (**correct**)
