

Quick -vs- Quickly (1)

*This sheet works with **adjectives and adverbs!***

Adjectives are generally used to modify (change) **nouns**

She is a very beautiful woman. / She is very beautiful.

Adverbs are used to modify **verbs** or other **adjectives** by adding "ly"

We quietly **snuck** into the movie theater.

*When modifying adjectives, the adverb tells you "how **adjective**" the situation is:*

Tom is incredibly **rich**. (*How **rich** is Tom? -Incredibly **rich**!*)

***If the adjective ends in "y", change it to "ily"*

The children happily **played** in the park.

***If the adjective ends in "e", delete it and change it to "ly"*

Bob is an amazingly **smart** guy.
