The OLD man -vs- The OLDEST man

This sheet is how to decide when to use a **regular** adjective or a **superlative** adjective after the word "the"

The old man. This just says there is a man and he is old. (Regular) *The old man had many great interesting stories.*

To use the superlative, you need to add things like: "in the world", "in history", "ever", etc.

The oldest man. This needs to be followed by one of the expressions mentioned above (superlative):

*For superlatives, you need things like: "in the world, in history, ever, etc.

That guy is the oldest man I have ever met.

This is the most dangerous place in town.

Decide whether you need a **regular** or a **superlative** adjective below: ex. This is the <u>most expensive</u> movie ever made. (expensive) 1.
