These are some of the most commonly used verb forms that appear on the test:

1. **have given** **has given** **give** **gives**

2. **do** **already did** **have never done** **aren't doing**

3. **have taken** **take** **took** **has taken**

At our school, we **take** your English learning very seriously. We **have taken** complete beginners and produced great speakers. Each student who **has taken** our courses has passed their tests. Over 500 students **took** tests last month and of course all passed!

4. **answers** **has answered** **having answered** **answer**

I have a special question for you all! No one **has answered** it correctly so far today, so I hope someone can **answer** it in this class. Be careful! Before **having answered** it, make sure you are correct. You only have one chance. Whoever **answers** correctly will get a nice prize!

5. **have been provided** **having provided** **provides** **provide**

(make something available for someone)
