These are some of the most commonly used verb forms that appear on the test:

1. **to write** **write** **have written** **wrote**

2. **the beginning** **began** **has begun** **to begin**

3. **are changing** **going to change** **to change** **be changed**

4. **had begun leaving** **are leaving** **leave** **have left**

5. **has had** **could have** **has** **to have**
