1. **decisive** **decide** **decisively** **decision**
(basic meaning: choose something // an important final result of an action or situation)

2. **completion** **completely** **complete** **completing**
(to finish something or do something until it's 100% finished)

3. **success** **successful** **succeed** **successfully**

4. **impressively** **impress** **impressive** **impression**
(do something that people think is great/amazing/etc.)

ABC Company put on an **impressive** show at the trade fair. They **impressively** displayed their new products with lights and lasers. I got the **impression** that they were able to strongly **impress** everyone there. I'm sure their sales will increase as a result.

5. **vacate** **vacant** **vacation** **vacantly**
(to leave a building or house / move out // place with no one living in it // empty of belief or thought)

The economic collapse forced many people to **vacate** their rented apartments. Now there are many **vacant** buildings all over the city. Many of these people also **vacantly** stared at rich families all taking a nice **vacation** somewhere at the same time.
