5.	significantly significant signify significance (large or important enough to have some effect or be noticed)
	We have seen a <u>significant</u> increase in sales since the launch of our new product. This product has <u>significantly</u> increased our customer base. Our higher profits <u>signify</u> the <u>significance</u> of our place in this market.
