1.	(basic meaning: have something in or added to something else)
	In an attempt to <u>include</u> everyone, management has created an all- <u>inclusive</u> weekend training trip, <u>including</u> airfare, accommodations and meals. The <u>inclusion</u> of airfare makes the trip affordable for our lower-salaried staff.
2.	remarkably remark remarkable remarking (say one's opinion // unusual or surprising, so people notice)
	My friend made a <u>remark</u> today about the growing number of homeless people. It is <u>remarkable</u> how, that in just a few years, it has so <u>remarkably</u> increased. We were <u>remarking</u> that the government has done almost nothing to address this issue.
3.	indicate indicative indicatively indication (show that something is true or exists, or is possible)
	The numbers clearly <u>indicate</u> that the company is losing a lot of money! This is <u>indicative</u> of poor management. There's no clear <u>indication</u> yet that management will be fired, but the board is <u>indicatively</u> hinting at it.
4.	delight to delight delightful delightfully (give someone great joy/happiness/pleasure) delightfully
	It was <u>delightful</u> to see that famous artist performing again after so many years. She <u>delightfully</u> danced and sang many of her old hits to the <u>delight</u> of her fans. She hopes <u>to delight</u> many more as she begins her 1 st world tour in 10 years.
5.	familiar familiarly familiarize familiarity (to know about something or try to get to know about something)
	At first, Ann was not really <u>familiar</u> with NY. So she walked the streets to <u>familiarize</u> herself with it. Now her <u>familiarity</u> with the city is amazing! Surprisingly, she found a place that is <u>familiarly</u> similar to places in her hometown.
